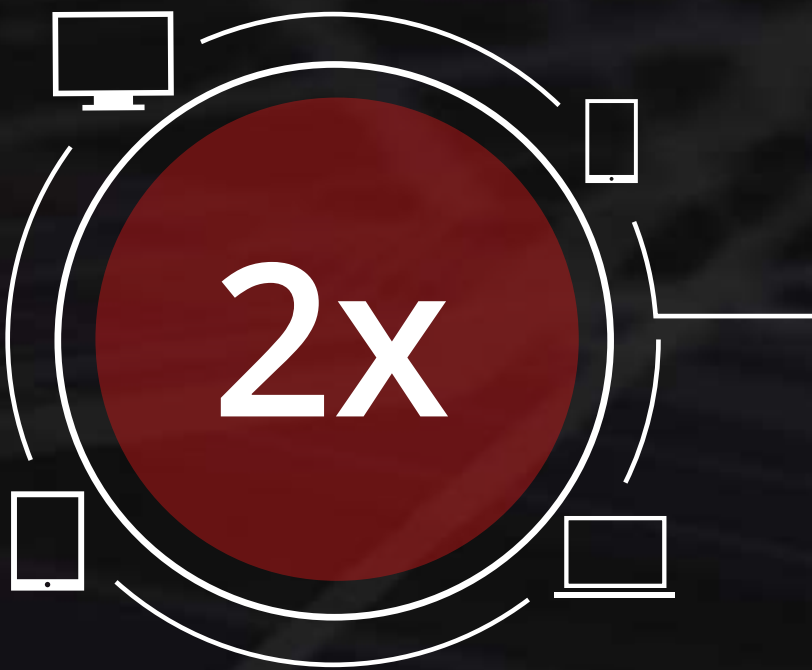
McAfee uncovered an exponential increase in threats targeting cloud services correlated with the increase in cloud use between January and April 2020.

Manufacturing and Education verticals increased cloud service usage even further, growing by 100% as more students learned from home and industries transitioned to remote work.

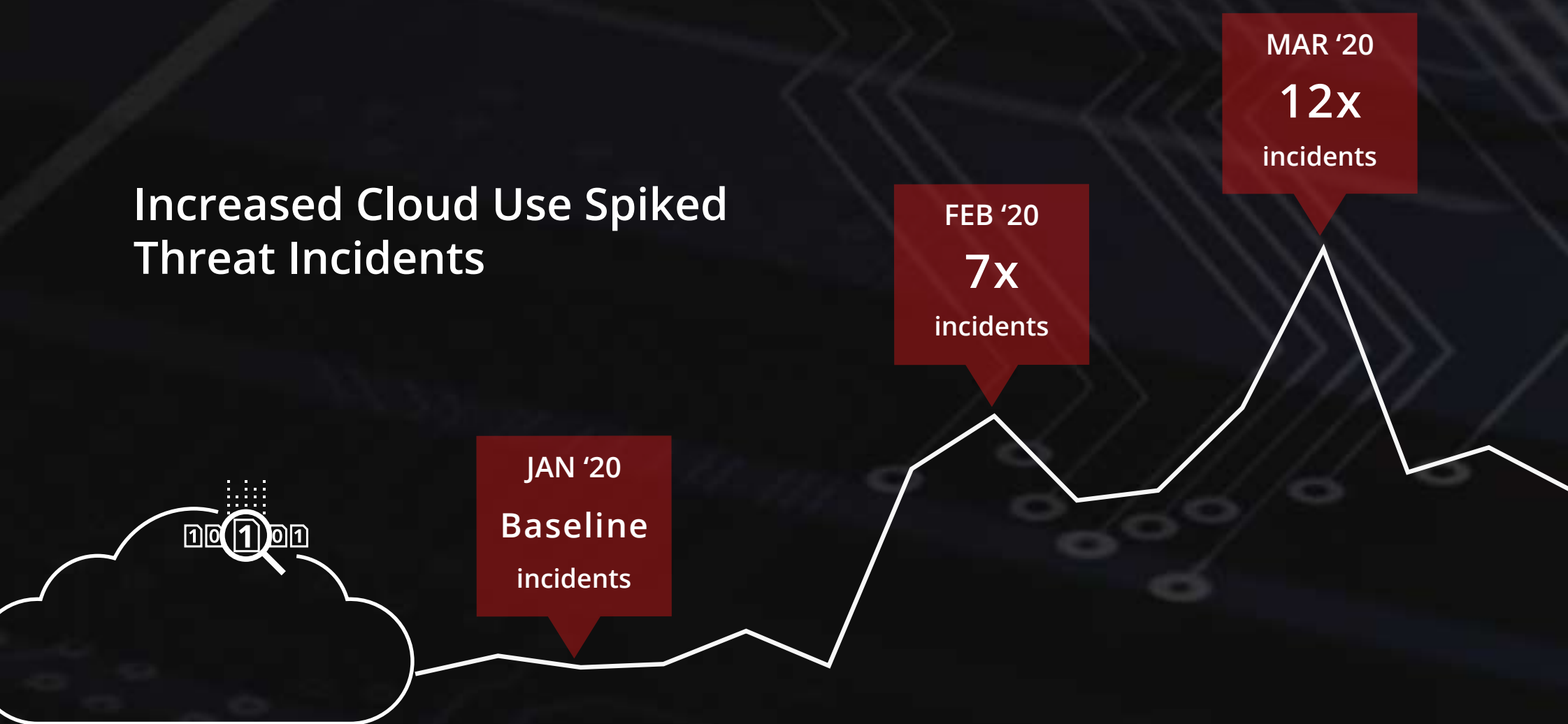
Use of Cloud Collaboration Services Skyrockets

Uncontrolled cloud access by unmanaged devices can lead to unrecoverable loss of sensitive data.

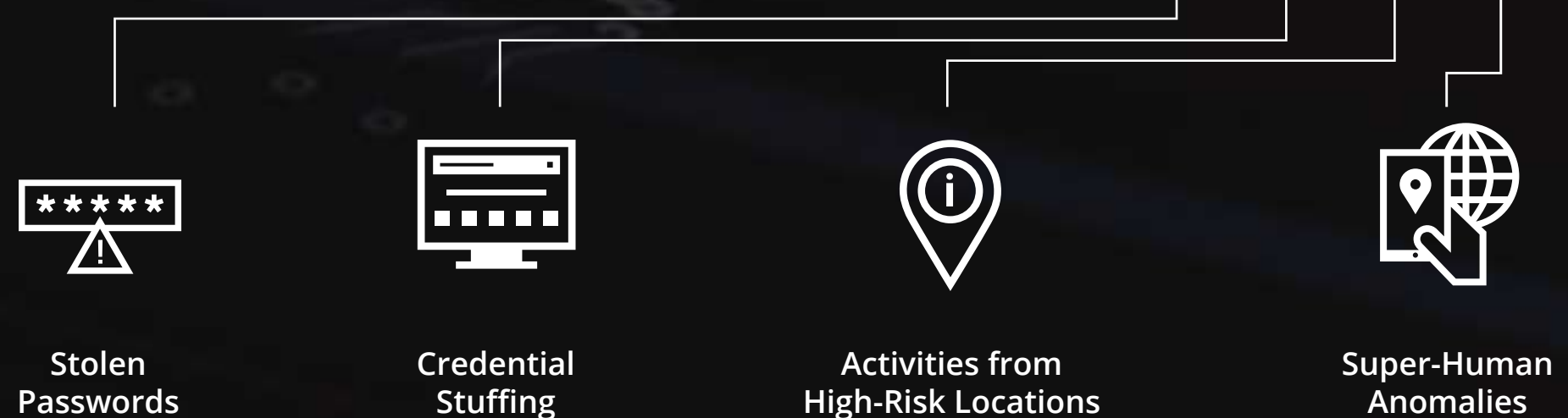
Increased Cloud Use Spiked Threat Incidents
